

Generally the exams in this class will contain 3 sections:

- 1) Multiple Choice
- 2) True/False
- 3) Fill-in/Short Answer

The proportion of each may vary a bit between exams, often depending on how many good questions we can come up with. A good idea would be to plan on these three sections being more or less evenly distributed in terms of the number of points we'll give to each section.

Sample Short Answer Questions:

1. There are two main causes of hypoxia (low oxygen content) in waters. Describe them and how they occur.

2. Describe/List 2 of the 3 ways we discussed in class that the TV shows "Family Guy" and "The Simpsons" differ. [we didn't really discuss these in class, this is just an example]

3. Name the six (6) major statements made by characters from the Simpsons TV show/movie. [Not to imply that there are only 6, but hey this is just an example. You will need to fill in the statements and characters. Though one might be given to you to get you started.]
